

PARENTS OF STUDENTS ENTERING 12TH GRADE:

Immunization (Vaccine) Requirements for Next School Year (2016-2017):

Indiana law requires that all students must be up to date on immunizations **by the first day of school.**

- ✓ **New Requirement for Students Entering 12th Grade:**
 - 2nd dose of MCV4 (meningococcal vaccine)

- ✓ **Other Recommended Vaccines (ask your Healthcare Provider)**
 - Hepatitis A
 - HPV- Cancer prevention
 - Bexsero – Meningitis B
 - Flu (every year)

A copy of your child's school immunization record will be included with their mailed report card (immunizations still needed for next year will be highlighted).

IMPORTANT: Indiana law states that only children who meet the criteria listed below will be able to receive immunizations from the Health Department. Some family physicians and local pharmacies (may need a doctor's prescription) will administer vaccines. Please schedule your child's appointment as soon as possible and turn in a copy of updated immunizations to your school nurse to avoid delays in starting school.

- ✓ Any form of Medicaid
- ✓ No health insurance
- ✓ Private insurance **only if:**
 - policy does not include vaccine coverage
 - specific vaccines not covered under policy
