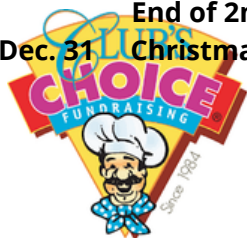


### COST FOR MEALS

THIS YEAR'S SCIENCE FAIR WILL BE HELD IN PERSON AND MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING: project board, research paper and an elevator pitch (video recording). FOR THOSE ADVANCING TO THE REGIONAL SCIENCE FAIR, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO ALSO UPOLOAD A DIGITAL POSTER BOARD (ON POWERPOINT) AND YOUR ELEVATOR PITCH (5 MIN. VIDEO RECORDING).**

Judging will take place on Wednesday, January 26TH, 2022 . Several winners will be chosen to represent Fremont Elementary at the Regional Science Fair to be held at Trine University on Saturday, March 19, 2022. Participation awards will be given to each participant and those advancing to the regional science fair will receive trophies. 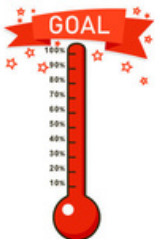
## MUSIC PROGRAM
