Registration for students planning to enter Kindergarten in the fall for the 2022/23 school year **is taking place during the month of February.**

Eligible students must be 5 years old by August 1, 2022. Parents are requested to stop in the elementary office between 8:30 a.m. and 2 p.m to enroll their child. Please bring your child's birth certificate, proof of residency and immunization/shot records. In addition to stopping in the office, parents will also be required to complete the online registration. Please share this information with your family, friends and neighbors.
